UNCLE JOHN'S • Perry

Made from juicy Michigan-grown Bartlett pears. Semi-dry & sparkling w/ carbonation; uncommonly refreshing. Showcases the delicate freshness of pear, with subtle citrus notes. Its buttery and creamy body balances its slight acidity. (*St. John's, MI*)

VIRTUE • Michigan Apple

Semi-dry cider from heirloom Michigan apples, blended w/ hand-pressed juice from this year's harvest. Ripe apples, a hint of oak, & a touch of sweetness. (*Fennville, MI*)

2018 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Beckman California

There's just no doubt that Santa Barbara County, once a fledgling wine region, is now all grown up and producing some of the country's best wines. Founded in 1994 in the Santa Ynez Valley subregion, Beckmen wines are crafted almost exclusively from two vineyards: Los Olivos District AVA, and Ballard Canyon AVA. Their estate Cab is an eye-opening experience. This offering is dark, rich, and dense, and loaded with vanilla, spice, cherry, cassis, black currant flavors and aromas and smooth tannins. 15%

2016 BORDEAUX SUPERIOR

Chateau de Bonhoste France

70% Merlot, 20% Cab. Sauvignon, 10% Cab. Franc. Estate was established in 1977 when Bernard & Colette Fournier purchased the 11th century chateau and its 44 hectares of vineyards, located 6 km south of St. Emilion. The garnet-colored wine has aromas of red fruits and toasty notes. Full-bodied, supple and balanced with silky tannins and fruity notes on the finish. 12%

2018 BARBERA

Ti Amo Lombardia, Italy

From the Pavia district of Lombardy, this 100% certified organic wine has the aroma of blackberries and spice and is soft but rich with a fruity palate. No oak. 13%

2018 RESERVE CÔTES DU RHONE

Famille Perrin France

Granache/Syrah/Mourvedre. This ripe fleshy wine is chock full of luscious mulberry & cassis flavors. Potent & fullbodied but a brisk mineral sheen on the midpalate lends freshness. Moderately long finish framed by fine, soft tannins. An excellent choice as one's everyday red wine. 13.5%

2014 GRÜNER VELTLINER

Pratsch Austria

100% Certified Organic. Herbal, fresh & spicy with notes of white pepper, apple & citrus on the palate. It has the "rainwater over rocks" minerality that's desirable in Austrian whites. Zippy acidity. 12%

2018 CHARDONNAY

Sean Minor Central Coast

Golden straw color. Aromas of apricot, apple, and honeydew with subtle notes of butter. On entry, tropical fruit notes with green apple flavors framed by nice acidity integrating well with the medium body mouth feel. Green apple & pear with juicy acidity provide a lengthy finish. 13.5%

2020 BORDEAUX BLANC AOC

Chateau La Frenelle France

60% Sauvignon Blanc, 30% Semillon, 10% Muscadelle. Family-owned since 1789. Brilliant transparent yellow color w/ green highlights. Intensely aromatic nose: lemons, grapefruit & white peaches from the Sauvignon, honeysuckle & acacia flowers from the Muscadelle. The Semillon brings richness & roundness. Crisp & fruity on the palate with a silky long finish. 12.5%

ROSÉS

2019 ROSÉ Pratsch Austria

100% Zweigelt. 100% organic wine made from estate-grown Zweigelt grapes (similar to Gamay.) Delicate and dry featuring aromas of wild strawberries, peaches and pears backed by crisp refreshing acidity. 13%

2020 JENNY AND FRANÇOIS ROSÉ Domaine de la Patience

Costières de Nimes, France

From the southernmost appellation of the Rhône and from organic grapes of the Domaine de la Patience, an easy-drinking, light rosé full of red berry fruit notes. Perfect for summer. Grenache/Cinsault 12%

VERMOUTH

ATXA VINO VERMOUTH ROJO

Destlerias Acha Spain

Enjoy as an aperitif over ice or straight up w/ a peel of orange or lemon. Traditional Vermouth is a fortified & aromatized wine macerated w/ herbs, fruits and roots. Atxa is made in accordance with an old family recipe with botanicals including wormwood, gentian, & cherry. Notes of licorice and wild herbs framed by bitter components and a markedly wild berry fruit. 15%

CHIMAY • Dorée

Mild & light in taste; floral aromas w/ a slight hint of smoked malt & a touch of bitter. The taste is set by hops, a dash of lemon/citrus and coriander.

LOUD BEERSEL • Oude Lambiek

Brewed at Brouwerij Boon and barreled at Oud Beersel, this is the base oude lambiek for OB's blends.

ST. FEUILLIEN • 5

Pale blond ale, clear & bright, with strong sparkling character. The nose is fresh & hoppy w/ delicate fruity hints empowered by nuances of citrus zests. Starts off sweet & slightly malty. Round & full-bodied with a fine, pleasant bitterness on the finish.

PALM • Speciale

Belgian Pale Ale made w/ English hops, French barley, Belgian yeast, & Champagne malt. Amber hued, but not heavy.

ST. BERNARDUS • Wit

Traditional Belgian white beer developed and brewed in collaboration with the legendary Master Brewer Pierre Celis. Very pale and quite hazy. In aroma, it has a wheaty, apple-like, tartness; herbal-spicy notes with coriander and orange fruitiness and honeyish sweetness. Very refreshing!

BOON • Oude Kriek

One of the finest & most authentic of the 100% spontaneously fermented fruit-Lambics. 400g/litre of wild cherries fermented together w/ a blend of young & old Boon lambic aged in oak casks. Unsweetened, unfiltered, unpasteurized.

MOORTGAT (DUVEL)

Duvel Single Fermented

Brewery staff at Duvel Moortgat have enjoyed this for decades and traditionally have cold-filtered a small portion of this beer for sale, at a few select places in Belgium, more widely in the UK & USA. Brewing & 1st fermentation takes about 30 days, at which stage this beer is called "single-fermented." Typical Duvel flavors & aromas are already emerging, but it's lower in alcohol & carbonation, with a slightly lighter, crisper taste.

CHIMAY • Première (AKA Red)

The oldest of the Chimays. Its coppery color and sweet, fruity taste make it a particularly tasty dark ale.

PETRUS • Sour Passionfruit

by De Brabantere

A blend of the famous Petrus Aged Pale sour (100% foederbeer aged 24 months in foeders) and passionfruit. The result is this genuinely marvelous Sour Passionfruit, a harmonious union of tart & sweet embodied in one single remarkable beer.

BARBĀR

Soft honey blond with a bouquet of floral and spicy citrus notes. Full of finesse and balance with just enough sweetness. A classic not to be missed when available.

KWAK

The fine lasting head offers aromas of wheat beer, w/ hints of bubblegum, vanilla, cloves & a touch of spirit. Very smooth & spritzzy, w/ vanilla notes on the palate; comes across very light for its strength. Sweet malt gives way to a dry finish.

MAREDSOUS • Brune 8

Sherry, allspice, & warm dark caramel aromas. Mild smoky roasted grain & dark fruit notes in the palate. Hints of tobacco & wood; soft sourness in the background.

TRIPEL KARMELIET by Bosteels

Golden ale w/ a creamy head. Restrained hoppiness, generous spicing, fruity banana & vanilla notes. Still brewed to an authentic beer recipe from 1679 from the former Carmelite monastery in Dendermonde.

ACHOUFFE • Houblon Chouffe

Flavored by 3 different types of hops. This Belgian India Pale Ale is appreciated for its pronounced bitterness combined with the fruity tones of traditional Achouffe beers.

DELIRIUM TREMENS by Huyghe

Hoppy strong golden ale w/ a lot of Saaz character. Spicy hop aroma, creamy nutty palate, & fruity dry warming finish.

BRASSERIE DUPONT

Avec Les Bon Voeux

The strongest of Dupont's farmhouse ales. A touch of honey sweetness, grassiness, a bit of hop bitterness, some of the distinctive Dupont yeasty funk & a nearly perfect amount of spritz.

DE DOLLE • De Dulle Teve

Blonde ale in the tradition of Belgian Triple. Its high density (20 Plato) stems from large amounts of pale malt increased with pale candy sugar in the brew kettle. Goldings hops adds slight bittering for balance. Unfiltered & unpasteurized.

LA TRAPPE • Quadrupel

Amber color, warm & intense flavor. Rich & finely balanced. Malty sweet, slightly burnt, & pleasantly bitter w/ a sweet aftertaste. (*Not Belgian, but Authentic Trappist from the Netherlands*)

GULDEN DRAAK

Dark Brown triple ale with a creamy head, natural malt, toffee like sweetness, hoppy accents, and a Barleywine strength.

SPENCER • Peach Saison 
A light, refreshing, sessionable ale. Delicate peach flavor is highlighted through sparkling carbonation producing a fresh, clean taste. (Spencer, MA)

SURLY • Hell
Not unlike a Zwicker Bier from Germany. Filtered & fermented w/lager yeast. American hops takes a back seat to the Pils malt sweetness & fresh bread aroma. The color is... hell (Deutsch for light). (Minneapolis)

ANCHOR • Steam
For many, this is the granddaddy of all craft beers. Fritz Maytag took over the dying Anchor Brewery in 1965. The flagship beer of this brewery founded in 1896 is the "steam" beer made w/a blend of pale & caramel malts, fermentation w/lager yeast at warmer ale temperatures in shallow open-air fermenters, and gentle carbonation in cellars through an all-natural process called kräusening. An American classic. (S.F., CA)

EINBECKER 
Brauherren Pils (Unfiltered)
The "historic unfiltered Brauherren Pilsner" displays the classic bitter character of Einbecker Premium Pils at its mature perfection. The Einbecker beer style dates back to April 23, 1378. During the 14th and 15th centuries every citizen in the town of Einbecker had the right to brew beer and by 1616 there were 742 citizens that owned brewhouses. In 1749 the town combined all the brewing rights and the Einbecker brauhaus was created. This easy drinking, crisp Pils is their flagship beer.

FIRESTONE WALKER • DBA
Double Barrel Ale. A tribute to the traditions of the great British Pale brewers of Burton-on-Trent, using Firestone Union oak barrels to create a mild blend of vanilla & toasted oak flavors touched w/an elegant hint of English noble hops. (Paso Robles, CA)

SIERRA NEVADA • Pale Ale
Deep amber color and an exceptionally full-bodied, complex character. Generous quantities of premium Cascade hops for fragrant bouquet and spicy flavor. (Chico, CA)

UNIBROU 
Blanche de Chambly
Produced with a blend of Quebec unmalted wheat & very pale barley malt to which spices & natural aromatics are added, along with a light hopping. (Chambly, Quebec, Canada)

BELLS • Bright White
An alternative to dark and heavy winter warmers and stouts, this is a stylish and refreshing Wheat Ale. Fermented with a Belgian ale yeast strain, a blend of barley and wheat malts yields a mixture of clove and fruity aromas, all without the use of any spices. (Comstock, MI)

ALLAGASH • White
Traditional Belgian-style wheat beer, light & slightly cloudy w/a blend of spices. Long-time Hopleaf mainstay! (Portland, ME)

DOVETAIL • Vienna Lager 
Copper in color w/a warm 100% Vienna malt character & Styrian Golding hop finish.

LAGROW • Citra Blonde 
Refreshing, refined, organic Blonde featuring orange zest, finishing off with a bubbly, smooth taste.

ALARMIST • Angel of Fire 
Collaboration Lager with The Chicago History Museum / Chicago Brewsecum to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the Chicago Fire and celebrate Anna & Joseph Hudlin. Roasted toffee aromatics, notes of bakers chocolate with a slight waft of molasses & stone fruit wrapped up neatly in roasted malts with a clean, dry finish.

FIRESTONE WALKER • Pivo Pils
Refreshing, light-bodied & hop-driven. Delicate lightly toasted malt flavors underscore noble German hop character. Hops: Hallertau-grown Magnum deliver the lupulin foundation while generous amounts of Spalter Select bring floral aromatic & spicy herbal notes. Dry hopped with German Saphir for a touch of bergamot zest & lemongrass. (Paso Robles, CA)

ALASKAN • Amber
The slow fermentation of this Alt Beer helps condition the flavors. Richly malty and long on the palate, with just enough hop backing to make this beautiful amber colored beer notably well balanced. (Juneau, AL)


BEGYLE • Flannel Pajamas

2 types of fruited wild ale, raspberry & blackberry aged for 2 years in oak barrels, blended w/a fresh brown ale creates this luxurious Flemish-style sour boasting complex notes of wood, chocolate, tart fruit & roasted malt.

Dortmunder Gold
Smooth lager w/more body & less hops than a pilsner, less malt & more hops than a Munich-style lager. (Cleveland, OH)

Delightfully smooth American Pale Ale w/ an addition of honey. Perfectly balanced.

OFF COLOR • Apex Predator 
Farmhouse Ale w/the sweet scent of juicy fruit & hazy, golden body. Generous Crystal dry-hopping completes the dry finish with a fruity bite.

Semi-tart, semi-sweet, American Wild Ale fermented with blackberry and lemon. (Niles, IL)

NB's original wood-conditioned beer, resting in French Oak barrels for 1-3 years. With sour apple notes, dry effervescence, & earthy undertones. (Fi. Collins, CO)

Double Dry-Hopped Tropical Hero
Hit the pipeline with a juicy riptide of pineapple, tangerine, and coconut character crested from massive waves of Sabro, Mosaic, and Citra hops. The soft, sweet sonic wave of tropical flavors rise out of each smooth, hazy sip.

TOPPLING GOLIATH • King Sue
With a ferocious bite that will make sure all learn to toe the line, this Citra hopped double IPA will make followers cheer and enemies crumble. But don't take this beer lightly, when King Sue is on a rampage, nothing will stand in it's way. (Decorah, IA)

BOULEVARD • Tank 7
A Boulevard version of a trad Belgian-style farmhouse ale. A big surge of fruity aromatics & grapefruit-hoppy notes; tapers to a peppery, dry finish. (Kansas City, MO)

Alive In Its Jaws
Bold in every dimension, this double dry-hopped double India pale ale elevates a super cast of Nelson Sauvin, Galaxy, Citra and Sabro hops upon a tempurpedic malt base.
