STORMALONG

White Mountain Magic

Unfiltered cider made with a blend of spices and a hint of New Hampshire Maple Syrup. It's savory, yet crisp with a delicious farmstand apple cider flavor combined with a freshly baked goods vibe. (Sherborn, MA)

5.2% **Goblet \$6**

ERIS • Pedestrian

Modern dry cider blended for everyone. Crisp, fresh, and pleasantly tart like a glass of Granny Smith.

5.9% **Goblet \$6**

GARAGISTE • Cherry Calamasi

A session mead made with organic honey, cherry, and Calamansi limes. 100% Natural. (Tampa, FL)

6.8% **Aspen \$11.50**

TANDEM • Dry Dabinett

Cider made from 100% Dabinett apples grown on Versnyder Farm in Lake Leelanau, MI. The Dabinett is a popular cider apple, especially in Europe. The most preferred "biter-sweet" apple in the cider community, Dabinett's certainly have bitterness and tannin present, and also a floral sweet characteristic that shines through. (Suttons Bay, MI)

6.9% **Goblet \$6.50**

FARNUM HILL • Dooryard (Still)

Aromas of honey, peach, and bittersweet apple, and the taste of beeswax, lime, and citrus peels, with barely-perceptible sweetness. Bright acid over broad bitter, and a full and moderately astringent mouthfeel. Very little to no carbonation. (Lebanon, NH)

TRILLIUM (Canton, MA)

Barrel-Aged Feed Your Soul

Collab with Weathered Souls Brewing. Featuring barley smoked on a Primitive Pit smoker over New England maple and oak. Rich baker's chocolate, caramelized brown sugar, sticky molasses, and freshly-ground coffee with an underlying complementary smoke profile.

Barrel-Aged Almond Cake

Imperial stout brewed w/ harmoniously blended dark malts and conditioned on Madagascar vanilla beans and toasted almonds. More than three years of subsequent maturation in bourbon barrels adds well-structured oak presence, mellow spirit character, and graceful smoothness.

15.7% **500mL Bottle \$40**

BELL'S • Black Note 2023 (Kalamazoo, MI)

Blends the complex aromatics of Expedition Stout with the velvety smooth texture of Double Cream Stout, each aged in freshly retired oak bourbon barrels for months.

11.1% **12oz Bottle \$14**

NORTH COAST • Old Stock (Fort Bragg, CA)

Like a fine port, Old Stock Ale is intended to be laid down. With an original gravity of over 1.100 and a generous hopping rate, Old Stock Ale is well-designed to round out and mellow with age. It's brewed with classic Maris Otter malt and Fuggles and East Kent Goldings hops, all imported from England.

TIMMERMANS ⚡

Lambicus Blanche

A traditional lambic blended with a Belgian White beer, and spiced with coriander. It's a refreshing beer with flavors of wheat, citrus and spicy notes.

4.5% **30cL Glass \$11.50**

GIRARDIN • Oude Lambiek ⚡

Base oude lambiek for Girardin blends and brewed on site. Very low to no carbonation, this version is rarely available on draft in this form.

5% **Aspen \$12**

BAVIK • Super Pils Unfiltered

Pure pils. No adjustments. Never pasteurized. Unfiltered. Super tasty!

5.2% **33cL \$7**

DE RANKE • XX Bitter

A blond ale that is bitter for Belgian standards. Using whole leaf Hallertau hop flowers, pale pilsner malt and loads of Brewers Gold.

6% **25cL \$11**

DE HALVE MAAN • Brugse Zot

A golden blonde, brewed with four different kinds of malt and two aromatic varieties of hop which give the beer its unique taste.

6% **33cL \$12**

ST. BERNARDUS • Tokyo Wit

An unfiltered ale, which has been brewed with a large amount of wheat, holding the middle between a white beer and a saison.

6% **25cL Goblet \$10**

BOON • Oude Kriek ⚡

One of the finest & most authentic of the 100% spontaneously fermented fruit-Lambics. Wild cherries fermented with a blend of young & old lambic aged in oak casks.

6.5% **25cL \$12**

DUVEL MOORTGAT • Duvel 6.66

The Duvel Moortgat family brewery celebrated its 150th anniversary in 2021 w/ this new mild, full-bodied blond. No fewer than 6 different hop varieties are used. It's based on the noble & exclusive hop varieties Saaz & Styrian Golding, just like classic Duvel.

6.8% **25cL Glass \$9**

WESTMALLE • Dubbel 🍷

For over 200 years, the monks of Westmalle have been choosing to live a life of prayer and work. There is a farm, a cheese dairy and a brewery inside the walls of the Trappist abbey. This beer is rich, complex, herby and fruity with a fresh-bitter finish.

7% **33 cL \$12**

CHIMAY • Red (Premiere) 🍷

The oldest of the Chimays. Its coppery color and sweet, fruity taste make it a particularly tasty dark ale.

7% **25cL Glass \$12**

MAREDSOUS • Brune

Brown beer with mahogany color; sherry, allspice, & warm dark caramel aromas. Mild smoky, roasted grain & dark fruit notes. Hints of tobacco & wood. Originally only brewed for Christmas, but over the centuries it became a year round staple.

8% **25cL \$10**

TRIPEL KARMELIET by Bosteels

A classic golden Belgian Tripel. Brewed using a 3-grain recipe rediscovered from the 1679 Carmelite monastery; refined yet balanced, with soft fruity notes and a surprisingly delicate taste.

BLAUGIES • La Moneuse

Named for A. J. Moneuse (b. 1768), a famous local bandit and gang leader, and ancestor of the brewers' family. It is a classic "saison" beer by virtue of its strength and its earthy, aged quality. It has a hardy, semi-dry malt character, a fresh but not overpowering hoppiness, abundant yeasty, fruity flavors and a fairly strong, but pleasant and enticing mustiness.

KWAK by Bosteels

A traditional strong Belgian amber ale. Pauwel Kwak was a brewer and owner of the "De Hoor" Inn in Dendermonde at the time of Napoleon. He commissioned a special Kwak glass to be blown, a glass that could be hung safely on a coach. Allowing any coachman who visited his inn to enjoy a beer on the road.

8.4% **33cL Glass \$14**

ST-FEUILLIEN • Triple

Traditional Abbey Triple that is sparkling orangish-golden in color with a brilliant white foam. Highly aromatic with vivid hop resins leaping out of the glass. The flavor is bright, malty, and spicy.

HUYGHE • Delirium Tremens

Pale blond and slightly malty with a nice touch of alcohol & spicy. Warming and round, with an aftertaste that is strong, long-lasting and dry bitter.

8.5% **25cL \$10**

ACHOUFFE • Houblon Chouffe

Flavored by three different types of hops. This Belgian India Pale Ale is appreciated for its pronounced bitterness combined with the fruity tones of traditional Achouffe beers: it softens the strongest of characters.

VAL-DIEU • Grand Cru

Quadrupel, with aromas of roasted malt, chocolate and port wine; finishes slightly dry.

10.5% **25cL \$12**

DE GARRE by Van Steenberge

This gem of a Belgian Triple is the house beer for the famous pub of the same name, located down a long alley in Bruges.

STRAFFE HENDRIK • Quad

The sophisticated blend of special kinds of malt give this beer a complex character, combining a delicate dryness w/ hints of coriander, dark fruits, anise and roasted chestnuts.

ART HISTORY BREWING

House Dark—Black Lager

Traditional Czech Dark Lager inspired by a classic from the 500-year-old U Flekú brewery in Prague. Rich & complex, black as coal; starts off like a Porter but finishes crisp, clean, & dry.

4.8% Pint \$7

House Pale—Pale Ale

Belgian-inspired Pale Ale fermented w/ a yeast from a Belgian Trappist monastery. Brewed w/ trad European malts & Belgian candy sugar but hopped with modern American Simcoe & Sultana hops. Food-friendly everyday drinker.

5.8% Pint \$7

HIDDEN HAND • The 77 ****

Naturally sparkling Chicago Neighborhood Lager—the preferred beer of the City of Win. The fortress city resting on the shores of the great water, forged together as a collection of 77 communities.

4% Pint \$5

ODELL • Sippin' Pretty

Loaded with a unique blend of açai, guava, & elderberry, balanced with a delicate addition of Himalayan pink sea salt. Bright pink color; refreshing with a slightly tart finish. (Fort Collins, CO)

4.5% 14oz. Teku Glass \$7

3 FLOYDS • Mr. Roper

Brewed in celebration of Michael's birthday. An English Bitter with aromas of citrus and flavors of marmalade, geranium, and magnolia. This small-batch, draft-only beer was brewed with 100% Golden Promise malt and 100% First Gold hops. (Munster, IN)

4.5% Pint \$8

FOREST AND MAIN • Bitter

English style bitter hopped entirely with U.K. Challenger and fermented it with London ale yeast. Notes of mixed citrus, cottage marmalade, apple pie with minimal spicing. (Ambler, PA)

4.6% Pint \$7.50

FIRESTONE • Brettfa Weiss 2017 ⚡

This beer honors the traditional beverage of the great Prussian capital, Berlin. Fredrick-the-Great was trained to brew it, and Napoleon's troops called it "The champagne of the North". This beer has held up with age. (Paso Robles, CA)

4.7% Aspen \$10.50

GOLDFINGER • Pils ****

Beautiful representation of German pilsner malt and noble hops. The inspiration for this beer comes from Brewer Tom's unforgettable experience drinking his favorite Pilsner in the German Alps. (Downers Grove, IL)

4.9% Pint \$8

BEGYLE • Dickey Riley ****

Brewed with Maris Otter malt, this malty red ale has a slightly sweet, biscuity flavor with a mildly bitter finish and aromas of caramel and raisin.

5% Pint \$6.50

HIRTER • Morchl

As one of Austria's oldest breweries, Hirt has been open since 1270. Their Dunkel is brewed with soft mountain spring water and roasted malts. Smooth and refreshing with dominant roasted malt flavors. (Austria)

5% .5L \$10

IS/WAS • Perceived Distance ****

Saison made in collaboration with Carl from Great Leap Brewing (大跃啤酒) in Beijing and Nunzino from Hop Head Farms in Michigan. The hops were harvested less than 48 hours before use. The result is a striking integration of crushed cardamom, nutmeg, coriander, and pink peppercorn with fresh orange and grapefruit zest and a wisp of cedar.

5.1% Goblet \$11

URBAN CHESTNUT

Pastaria Pilsner

Features an elegant light body, a soft palate of lightly bready malts, and a more intense spicy, floral hop character than a typical Pilsner thanks to the use of dry hopping. (St. Louis, MO)

5.2% 14oz. Teku Glass \$6.50

TIPOPILS • Hop Back

Made specifically for 2024 Tipopils Day, with a technique that involves the recirculation of the warm wort through a column of Petit Blanc variety flower hops. Aromas of crunchy cherry, melon, white flowers and lemon blossom. (Limido Comasco, Italy)

5.2% .3L Glass \$10

SCRATCH • Hickory Lager

Rustic blonde lager beer brewed with toasted hickory bark. Crisp and clean with a very light finish of toasted marshmallow and campfire smoke. (Ava, IL)

5.2% Goblet \$12

ART HISTORY • Shambles ****

English malts and hops give this porter a bready, floral and chocolate aroma. Sweet malt flavors of caramel, toffee and dark chocolate with a medium bitterness on the finish. (Geneva, IL)

5.3% Pint \$8.50

ANDECHS • Weissbier Hell

Traditional Weissbier brewed by one of the last genuine monastery breweries managed by an active religious order, entirely independent of corporations. The Benedictines of St. Boniface Abbey have been serving people in Andechs since 1455. (Andechs, Bayern Germany)

SOLEMN OATH ****

Extra Small Wave City Club

Hazy double dry hopped IPA, w/ lemon, lime ripples of Citra blown effortlessly to shore by the tropical blueberry lime zest breeze of Mosaic and Motueka. (Naperville, IL)

5.5% Pint \$8

DE GARDE • The Château ⚡

A four year blend of spontaneously fermented beer aged in barrels, with an average total age of approximately 29 months in oak. After tasting and blending, the beer was further conditioned for approximately 5 more months. (Tillamook, OR)

5.5% Goblet \$12

ALLAGASH • White

Traditional Belgian-style wheat beer, light & slightly cloudy w/ a blend of spices. Long-time Hopleaf mainstay! (Portland, ME)

5.5% Pint \$8

HOLY GOAT • Doom Witch

A blended sour red ale combining 80% "young" stock beer aged in steel, with around 20% "mature" beer aged in Scottish whisky barrels (Longmorn & North British). This blended base was transferred onto the spent fruit (tayberries) and re-fermented with locally grown Scottish strawberries from 2023 harvest. (Dundee City, Scotland)

6% Aspen \$14

3 FLOYDS • Zombie Dust

This intensely hopped and gushing undead Pale Ale will be one's only respite after the zombie apocalypse. (Munster, IN)

6.5% Pint \$8

TRILLIUM • Secret Stairs

Their signature Boston Stout. Bold and balanced; satisfying with a substantial body, but not syrupy or sweet. Roasted malt provides a nutty, earthy backdrop to bitter cocoa and little hints of caramel. (Canton, MA)

6.5% 14oz. Teku Glass \$12

PIPEWORKS ****

Blood of the Unicorn

Aggressively hopped red ale loaded with fruit and piney American hops.

6.5% Pint \$7.50

HALF ACRE • Vallejo ****

Seasonal West Coast IPA, dank, bright with notes of white grape jelly and under ripe peach.

6.7% Pint \$8

AYINGER • Maibock

A Bavarian n Spring Celebration beer brewed in the fall and lagered over the winter, Maibock will remind you that big beers can be elegant, and that some of the best beers anywhere on earth are brewed at a Bavarian village in the foothills of the Alps. (Bayern, Germany)

7% .4L \$10

MAINE • Lunch

"East Coast" version of a West Coast-style IPA. Intense hop flavors and aromas of tropical & citrus fruits & pine dominate, w/ a subtle malt sweetness. (Freeport, ME)

7% Pint \$12

BEACHWOOD • Citraholic

Hopheads rejoice! West Coast IPA double-dry-hopped for 2 weeks w/ lots of Citra, & a touch of Columbus, imparting heavy aromas of citrus & tropical fruits w/ melon & gooseberry nuances. (Long Beach, CA)

7.1% Pint \$9

ALLAGASH • Hive 56 ⚡

A barrel-aged dark sour ale brewed with fresh honey from their own beehives. A year of fermentation with a special blend of yeast strains—in a large foudre—develops aromas of strawberry, lemon, and even tropical fruit. (Portland, ME)

7.3% Aspen \$10.50

GOLDFINGER ****

Zlotonator Doppelbock

The Munich monks invented the Doppelbock to sustain them during lengthy fasts, particularly during lent. This beer has a nice rich, malty sweetness, deep flavors of molasses, caramel, and dark fruit finish with an earthy mineral quality. (Downers Grove, IL)

7.8% 14oz. Teku Glass \$7.50

EQUILIBRIUM • Star Light

Collaboration with Trillium Brewing. Imperial hazy IPA, with Citra, Mosaic and a Galaxy dry hop. Flavors of mango and pulpy grove stand OJ. (Middletown, NY)

8% 10oz. Glass \$11

MAINE • Dinner

Special double IPA made with 7 lbs of Citra, Falconer's Flight, Mosaic and Simcoe hops per barrel. Aromas of mango, passionfruit, and pineapple. (Freeport, ME)

8.2% 10oz. Glass \$10

POLLYANNA • Jötunheimr ****

Eisbock is the apex of lagerbier. The White Whale, Jötunheimr is an Eisbock Lager that was freeze distilled on a balmy -11F Illinois night to transform an 8.0% ABV Bock Lager into a 10.0% ABV Eisbock. Freeze distilled by Pollyanna's St Charles distillery. (Lemont, IL)

10% 10oz. Glass \$10

PERENNIAL • Abraxas 2023

Imperial stout with ancho chili peppers, cacao nibs, cinnamon sticks, and vanilla beans. (St. Louis, MO)

10.5% Bell Glass \$10

OFF COLOR ****

Barrel Aged Dino S'mores (Wild Turkey)

Almost 23 months of extended bourbon barrel aging in Wild Turkey 101 barrels. Raucous bourbon, seductive brownie batter malts, and a sort of impossibly silky body.

11% Bell Glass \$8

EGGENBERG

Samichlaus Classic 2021

As one of the rarest specialty dopplebocks in the world, brewed one day a year, then aged for 10 months. Complex dry toasted malt nose, intensely sweet on the palate and lightly carbonated. (Austria)

GOOSE ISLAND ****

Kaleidoscope Cuvee

A testament to their legacy in brewing, blending and barrel aging. Imperial Stout, Oatmeal Stout, Rye Stout and Barleywine Aged 18-36 months in: 41% Bourbon barrels, 30% Rum barrels, 11% Port wine barrels, and 7% Maple syrup barrels.

ALESMITH • BA Pierre Seine 2021

Belgian style strong dark ale aged in Red wine and Cognac barrels. Complex with a rich sweet malty presence. The fruity esters contain raisin, plum, dried cherry, fig or prune notes. (San Diego, CA)

REVOLUTION ****

Cafe Deth 2023

Fresh whole-bean coffee from Chicago's own Dark Matter Coffee stirs the senses in this barrel-aged Imperial Oatmeal stout. Haunting aromatics of roast and dried fruit enter the realm of toasted walnut and rich chocolate.
