HAYKIN • Jonagrimes 2024

Jonagrimes is an antique apple that is a cross of two famous heirlooms: Jonathan and Grimes Golden. From its boldly-flavored parentage, the apple bursts with the character of Bing cherries, and lemon-lime soda. 75% Jonagrimes and 25% Gala. (Aurora, CO)

SUPERSTITION MEADERY

Blueberry Spaceship Box

A blend of tart apples and semi-sweet blueberries. Massive blueberry aroma plays with green apple, rose and orange blossom. (Prescott, AZ)

CASTELLUM • Ube

A limited release, unique cider made with real ube (purple yam.) Subtle apple sweetness is balanced with the ube characteristics of coconut, vanilla, white chocolate and a slight nuttiness. (San Diego, CA)

UNCLE JOHN'S • Apple

Full-flavored, crisp and refreshing with just the right amount of carbonation. Made from apples grown just steps from their winery. (St. John's, MI)

Founded in 1873 By Stéphanie Friart, great-grand-aunt of Benoit and Dominique Friart. Back then, she ran a brewery located at the entrance of Roelux; it produced light beers. Stéphanie received several awards, notably at the Universal Exhibition in Antwerp in 1894 and, in 1895, at the International Exhibition of Foodstuffs in Geneva.

Grisette is an ancient heritage beer unique to the Hainaut province of Belgium. At the end of the 19th century, every tiny brewery in the area was making its own high-fermentation pale ale, casked in wooden barrels. This beer was known as "Grisette".

Grisette was produced continuously until about 1940. The brand was still used in the 50s, but the beer sold then no longer resembled the original and the traditional variety disappeared.

At Brasserie St-Feuillien, the first **Grisette Ambrée** dates back to 1919; it was relaunched in 1985, followed by a Blonde variant in 1995 and a Blanche in 1999.

The Hopleaf welcomes back **Grisette Blanche** after not being available in Chicago for many years.

ST FEUILLIEN • Grisette Blanche

This traditional Belgian white beer stands on its own. At the start of the century, in Hainaut, every small brewery produced this style of beer which was drawn from wooden barrels.

ST FEUILLIEN • Grand Cru

This extra-blond amber nectar masterpiece undergoes refermentation in the bottle, resulting in a beer endowed with unforgettable character. The secret lies in the unique combination of the noblest hops and the finest aromatic ingredients. Grand Cru differs from other beers in the range by its absence of spices and a traditional dry hopping with Styrian Golding hops in bloom.

ST FEUILLIEN • Quadrupel

A very dark and dense beer. This quadruple distinguishes herself by a complex and finely caramelized aroma and with shades of Madeira wine, candied fruit and an intense touch of fermentation esters. A slight hoppy smell completes the whole. The mouth is long with a powerful body built on the density and generous apparent extract. The bitterness is present but sweet and blends harmoniously with the malty structure. The selection of special malts raises the chocolate side with the nuances of coconut.

VAL-DIEU

Blanche de Liège Rosée

A raspberry Witbier that is perfectly balanced. This fruity beer has delicious aromas of freshly picked raspberries balanced by the sparkling witbier.

TILQUIN • Mûre ⚡

A spontaneous fermentation beer obtained from the fermentation of fresh & frozen blackberries, using a blend of 50% of Meerts and 50% of 1 and 2 years old lambics.

Obtains its unique flavor through an exceptional brewing process. Uses aromatic hops and guarantees a long and cold maturation process. Crisp Belgian Pils.

SILLY • Stupid Silly Sour ⚡

Formerly used solely for the purpose of blending into their Saison and Silly Sour, Stupid Silly Sour has extreme green apple sour notes and subtle hints of brown sugar and biscuit malt.

DE HALVE MAAN • Brugse Zot

A golden blonde, brewed with four different kinds of malt and two aromatic varieties of hop which give the beer its unique taste.

ST. BERNARDUS • Kombi

An Unfiltered Helles Lager, the first time St. Bernardus has made a bottom fermented beer! Luckily they had the help of the oldest brewery in the world, Weihenstephan. Brewed according to German Reinheitsgebot (The German beer purity law.) A true collab from two of the world's best breweries.

VERHAEGHE ⚡

Duchesse de Bourgogne

Refreshing Flemish old red/brown ale, matured for months in oak casks. Smooth, rich texture w/ an interplay of passion fruit, chocolate and a long dry acidic finish.

DUVEL MOORTGAT • Duvel 6.66

The Duvel Moortgat family brewery celebrated its 150th anniversary in 2021 w/ this new mild, full-bodied blond. No fewer than 6 different hop varieties are used. It's based on the noble & exclusive hop varietal Saaz & Styrian Golding, just like classic Duvel.

WESTMALLE • Dubbel

For over 200 years, the monks of Westmalle have been choosing to live a life of prayer and work. There is a farm, a cheese dairy and a brewery inside the walls of the Trappist abbey. This beer is rich, complex, herby and fruity with a fresh-bitter finish.

VAN STEENBERGE • Piraat 7

A strategically-hopped Belgian Tripel with soft floral and bright citrus hop flavors, it walks the line between Blonde ale, triple and a soft IPA. It is a true "living beer" with secondary fermentation.

MAREDSOUS • Brune

Abbey Brown brewed by Benedictine monks of the Abbey of Maredsous in the Belgian Ardennes. Originally only brewed for Christmas but has become a year round staple.

CHIMAY

White (Cinq Cents)

A classic unpasteurized Trappist Tripel, originally brewed in 1966. Rich fruity taste balanced w/ floral notes & nuances of spices.

ACHOUFFE • La Chouffe

Pale Blonde ale with citrus notes, followed by a refreshing touch, pleasantly spiced. Light hop profile. This was the first beer made at the brewery 40 years ago.

HUYGHE • Delirium Red

Fruit ale that is sweet and fruity, with a nice balance between sweet and sour. Hints of almond and mildly sour cherries.

ST. BERNARDUS • Abt 12 Nitro

Widely regarded as one of the best beers in the world. It is brewed in the classic Quadrupel style and adheres to the original 1946 recipe. The nitrogen version makes it more delicate, smooth, rich and creamy.

KASTEEL • Donker

A quadrupel and the first beer Kasteel made. Hints of caramel, coffee & chocolate. The sweet initial taste makes this beer surprisingly complex.

DE GARRE by Van Steenberghe

This gem of a Belgian Triple is the house beer for the famous pub of the same name, located down a long alley in Bruges.

Monk's Stout

First made in the 1950s in at the Dupont farm-brewery. Dry classic version of a Belgian stout, with a slight touch of fruit that balances it on the palate.

Saison Dupont

Regarded as a classic Belgian seasonal ale, this beer was designed to quench the thirst of farm workers. Brewed in winter, it is left to ferment in wooden barrels before being served.

Moinette Blonde

A complex Blonde ale, created in 1955 & Dupont's flagship product in Belgium. The name "Moinette" is a corruption of the old French "moëne", meaning "swamp", a very common feature in the region at the time.

House Dark—Black Lager

Traditional Czech Dark Lager inspired by a classic from the 500-year-old U Fleků brewery in Prague. Rich & complex, black as coal; starts off like a Porter but finishes crisp, clean, & dry.

House Pale—Pale Ale

Belgian-inspired Pale Ale fermented w/ a yeast from a Belgian Trappist monastery. Brewed w/ trad European malts & Belgian candy sugar but hopped with modern American Simcoe & Sultana hops. Food-friendly everyday drinker.

GOLDFINGER • Grodziskie 🇵🇱

Once referred to as the "Polish Champagne," this lager is an homage to the historical Polish style that features 100% oak smoked wheat malt. Smoky, dry, lemon zest, and wheat bread flavors.

HIDDEN HAND**The 77 Lager**

Crisp and refreshing light lager crafted in homage to the 77 Chicago communities.

(Naperville, IL)

DOVETAIL**Summer Hopfenlager**

A tropically-bent pale lager with Vista and Strata hops. Crisp lager taste with pineapple & tangerine notes from the hops.

CROOKED STAVE • Sour Rose ⚡

Wild ale fermented with mixed culture of wild yeast, it then undergoes fermentation in large oak foeders on second-use with raspberries and blueberries. Unfiltered and naturally wild. (Denver, CO)

PHASE THREE ⚡**Frog Stack**

Fruited Gose w/ heaps of pineapple, passion fruit, & mango, finished w/ a sweet kiss of marshmallow. Full-bodied, juiced up tropical smoothie vibes.

HIRT • Hirter Morchl

As one of Austria's oldest breweries, Hirt has been open since 1270. Their Dunkel is brewed with soft mountain spring water and roasted malts. Smooth and refreshing with dominant roasted malt flavors.

SIERRA NEVADA • Summerfest

A refreshing summer lager. Bright, balancing delicate and complex malt alongside spicy, floral hops. Hints of lemon zest lead into a dry finish. (Chico, CA)

Belgian-Style Blonde Ale, light-bodied and dry with a hint of fruitiness from the yeast.

Daisy Cutter

Sixteen years ago this American west coast Pale Ale was created. Chock full of dank, aromatic hops that bite up front, then ease into citrus.

Nebula Double Daisy Cutter

A Double IPA w/ creamsicle smoothie vibes, it has a sound bitterness and tons of papaya, guava, pineapple, & grapefruit notes.

AZADI • Goa ⚡

Summer-friendly sour w/ notes of guava, passionfruit, and papaya. The tropical fruit flavor is complimented by Galaxy hops.

ROTHAUS**Pils Tannen Zäpfle**

Aromatic Tettanang and Hallertau hops, domestic malt from summer barley, and pure spring water from the high Black Forest give this balanced Pils it's unique spicy and fresh taste. (Germany)

OFF COLOR • Ghost Lemons 🇺🇸

Collab w/ Allagash, a witbier w/ a twinge of tartness. First blush of summer peaches, preserved lemon and marmalade leads to a verdant, round mouthfeel of kiwi, hay, and barnyard funk.

MAPLEWOOD**Floaty Bid**

English IPA carefully balanced w/ a moderately aggressive hop character balanced by a medium-bodied, biscuit-like and toffee-tinged malt profile.

IS/WAS • Saison Dègel 🇺🇸

Saison brewed with chamomile, lavender, & honey. Complex floral nose w/ notes of round chamomile, herbaceous lavender, all-spice, wet straw, and wisps of pipe tobacco.

FIRESTONE WALKER**Pivo Pils**

Pivo is the beer that helped kick the doors down and liberated American pilsner from the clutches of industrial beer. Inspired by the dry-hopped Tipopils from Birrificio Italiano, Brewmaster Matt Brynildson drew upon multiple European influences to create this one-of-a-kind beer that sparked a legion of new craft pilsners across the U.S. (Paso Robles, CA)

ROARING TABLE**Secret Beach**

Their take on a classic Bavarian wheat beer. Notes of banana bread and clove mingle with a soft, creamy body. (Lake Zurich, IL)

ALLAGASH • White

Traditional Belgian-style wheat beer, light & slightly cloudy w/ a blend of spices.

Longtime Hopleaf mainstay! (Portland, ME)

ANDECHS • Weissbier Hell 🇩🇪

Traditional Weissbier brewed by one of the last genuine monastery breweries managed by an active religious order, entirely independent of corporations.

The Benedictines of St. Boniface Abbey have been serving people in Andechs since 1455. (Bayern, Germany)

GREEN MAN • ESB

A classic, brewed with 100% English ingredients. Using only Simpsons Malts, English Fuggle hops & a classic English ale yeast strain. Malty notes of toasted biscuit, toffee & caramel, along w/ dried fruit from the yeast. (Asheville, NC)

BELL'S • Oberon

Wheat ale that is sunshine in a glass. Citrusy, easy drinking and refreshing.

(Kalamazoo, MI)

OUTER RANGE • Aerials

West Coast IPA with Cashmere and Mosaic hops for a floral and crisp hop finish.

(Frisco, CO)

3 FLOYDS • Zombie Dust

This intensely hopped and gushing undead Pale Ale will be one's only respite after the zombie apocalypse. (Munster, IN)

SCRATCH**Chanterelle Biere de Garde**

A scratch classic! Farmhouse ale brewed with chanterelle mushrooms. Crisp malt profile from the Pilsner, Vienna, and Munich malts from Sugar Creek. Robust apricot aroma with a classic mushroomy cellar finish. (Ava, IL)

FIRESTONE WALKER**Wandering Don**

IPA features bold tropical, pine, & citrus aromatics. Brewed w/ Odell Brewing to celebrate the 2025 Firestone Walker Invitational Beer Fest. (Paso Robles, CA)

FONTA FLORA • Mimosa City

A mimosa-style white ale fermented with fresh oranges, conditioned on earl grey tea and coriander. (Nebo, NC)

BEACHWOOD • Thrillseeker

IPA generously hopped with Chinook, Summit, Centennial, & Simcoe for a massive citrus and tropical hop profile. Dry hopped with Simcoe and Chinook for an über fresh resinous aroma. (Long Beach, CA)

MARZ • Gay IPA 🇩🇪

Double Dry Hopped Hazy IPA brewed in celebration of Pride Month. The hop blend of Strata, El Dorado, and Citra provide a bouquet of ripe apricot, papaya, and mango with Lactose. (Chicago, IL)

ILLUMINATED**Gay Agenda**

Double Dry-Hopped Double IPA w/ peaches. Illuminated donates 10% of all profits to Chicago's Broadway Youth Center, which is a welcoming space for LGBTQ+ youth & young people experiencing homelessness or housing instability. (Chicago, IL)

PIPEWORKS**Unicorns Aren't Real**

Herbal bitter IPA finishes with some dankness. Made w/ Citra, Mosaic, Simcoe, Cryo Citra, Cryo Mosaic & Cryo Simcoe.

BROOKLYN**Black Chocolate Stout**

Russian Imperial Stout w/ dark chocolate aroma and flavor achieved through the artful blending of six malts and three distinct mashes. (Brooklyn, NY)

10% Teku Glass \$8

THE LOST ABBEY**Judgment Day**

A Belgian style quad. A stronger and more contemplative version of their Lost and Found Ale. Many of the Trappist Breweries produce a version of this beer which ages incredibly well for many years to come. (San Marcos, CA)

GOOSE ISLAND**Bourbon County Original 2023**

Stout aged in a mix of freshly emptied bourbon barrels from Buffalo Trace, Heaven Hill, Four Roses and Wild Turkey distilleries. Barrel aged for an average of 12 months. Deeply developed flavors of fudge, vanilla, and caramelized sugar.

DEEP WOOD SERIES**REVOLUTION** 🇺🇸**Deth's Tar 2024**

A prolonged repose in bourbon-soaked American oak barrels adorns a dark chocolate profile with notes of toasted coconut and vanilla. A rich, supple texture belies the unholy power of this Imperial Oatmeal Stout.

FAIR STATE • Little Yellow Car
