TANDEM • Smackintosh
McIntosh, Rhode Island Greening, and Northern Spy. Everything's better with a little Smack. This crowd pleaser is sweet and tart with full apple flavor. (*Suttons Bay, MI*)

HAYKIN
Muscadet De Bernay 2023
This blend is dominated by Muscadet De Bernay, a cider apple found in the mid 1700's at a Benedictine Abbey in Bernay, France. It exudes the flavor of dark chocolate, blackberry, orange marmalade, & coffee. It is rich & complex. Muscadet De Bernay, blended with Dabinett and Zabergau Reinette apples from Idle Acres. (*Aurora, CO*)

EDEN • Peak Bloom
Blends heirloom varieties from Vermont orchards. Lush apple fruit w/ soft tannins & bright notes of white grape, applesauce, & lime. Macintosh, Empire, Dabinett, Spartan & Esopus Spitzenburg apples grown at Eden's own orchard in Newport, VT and in partner orchards Scott Farm, Dummerston, VT, Sunrise Orchards, Cornwall, VT, Yates Family Orchard, Hinesburg, VT & Poverty Lane Orchards, Lebanon, NH. (*Newport, VT*)

UNCLE JOHN'S • Heirloom
Utilizing a blend of apple varieties such as McIntosh, Baldwin & Cortland, grown on 50+ year old trees. Most apple trees are ripped out after 20 years as modern American orchards grow for store shelves. (*St. John's, MI*)

FARNUM HILL • Dooryard (Still)
Dry cider w/ aromas of honey, peach, and bittersweet apple. Taste of beeswax, lime, and citrus peels, w/ barely-perceptible sweetness. Bright acid, a full and moderately astringent mouthfeel. Little to no carbonation. (*Lebanon, NH*)

VIRTUE • Jack Pine 2025
A blend of Dabinett, Northern Spy, Wine-sap, and Golden Russet from the 2023 and 2024 Harvest. A sharp and bright cider w/ a firm tannic finish. (*St. John's, MI*)

NORTHMAN Orchard Project 2024
Dabinett and Esopus Spitzenburg apples sing harmoniously amidst aromas of warm apricot, maraschino cherry and green apple. Fruit forward, with a delicate body and fresh acid, rounded out by smooth, integrated tannin. Blend of Dabinett and Esopus Spitzenburg apples from Dietrich Orchards, Conklin, MI.

The worlds oldest lambic brewery, Timmermans has brewed lambic in Itterbeek forover 300 years, since 1702. A few miles from the center of Brussels, it was previously known as "The Mole Brewery." Owned by Jan Vandermeulen, it was also a farm, an orchard, a café and a malt-house.

Lambicus Blanche ⚡ 🇧🇪
A traditional lambic and, as with Belgian white beers, spiced with coriander. Refreshing, with flavors of wheat, citrus and spicy notes.

Lambicus Faro ⚡ 🇧🇪
A historical Brussels beer. Candy sugar is delicately added to a traditional barrel-aged lambic, giving a sweeter note with apple aromas.

Authentic, yet bold fruity beer, crafted with traditional barrel-aged lambic and 100% natural raspberries, delicately spiced up with hibiscus.

BAVIK • Super Pils Unfiltered
Pure pils. No adjustments. Never pasteurized. Unfiltered. Super tasty!

BLAUGIES • Saison d'Epeautre
Classic Saison ale brewed w/ spelt. Very dry & a hint of wheaty tartness. It has a wonderfully heady, musty, cellar character that is unmistakably Belgian & a lot like champagne.

BRASSERIE DUPONT Saison Dupont
Regarded as a classic Belgian seasonal ale, this beer was designed to quench the thirst of farm workers. Brewed in winter, it is left to ferment in wooden barrels before being served.

DUVEL MOORTGAT • Duvel 6.66
A mild, full-bodied blonde ale. Just like the classic Duvel, it's based on the noble & exclusive hop varieties Sazaz and Styrian Golding. Mild, expressive & deliciously drinkable.

WESTMALLE • Dubbel 🍷
For over 200 years, the monks of Westmalle have been choosing to live a life of prayer and work. There is a farm, a cheese dairy and a brewery inside the walls of the Trappist abbey. This beer is rich, complex, herby and fruity with a fresh-bitter finish.

BOERENERF • Mirabelle 2024 ⚡
Blend of young & old lambics macerated with Mirabelle plums sourced from Vergers Dettling in Alsace, France. Mirabelle plums have wonderful aromas & is a delicious stone fruit that is not necessarily eaten on its own; it needs to be prepared.

VAN STEENBERGE • Piraat 7
A strategically-hopped Belgian Tripel with soft floral and bright citrus hop flavors, it walks the line between Blonde ale, triple and a soft IPA. It is a true "living beer" with secondary fermentation.

PETRUS • 50/50 ⚡
Blend of 50% Petrus Aged Pale & 50% Petrus Aged Red. Aged Pale is 100% "Mother Beer" aged in oak foeders. Aged Red is 85% Dubbel Bruin base with 15% Petrus Aged Pale added to give it a sour essence. Fresh cherries are added to complete the sweet and sour balance.

FANTÔME • Dark Chocolat
A Belgian dark farmhouse ale with cocoa and chili pepper. Slightly acidic finish w/ soft chocolate notes.

KWAK by Bosteels
A traditional strong Belgian amber ale. Pauwel Kwak was a brewer and owner of the 'De Hoorn' Inn in Dendermonde at the time of Napoleon. He commissioned a special Kwak glass to be blown, a glass that could be hung safely on a coach. Allowing any coachman who visited his inn to enjoy a beer on the road.

TRIPEL KARMELIET by Bosteels
A classic golden Belgian Tripel. Brewed using a 3-grain recipe rediscovered from the 1679 Carmelite monastery; refined yet balanced, with soft fruity notes and a surprisingly delicate taste.

VAN STEENBERGE • Winter
A Belgian strong ale. Lightly spiced with/ notes of fig and raisin. A nice treat during the cold winter months.

CHIMAY • Blue Grande Réserve 🍷
First brewed as a Christmas beer by the monks of Scourmont Abbey in 1956. It begins with a light sweet note before the creamy caramel transitions to a soft Mocha combined with an intense spicy taste, culminating in a delicious candied fruit finish.

ST. BERNARDUS • Abt 12 Nitro
Widely regarded as one of the best beers in the world. It is brewed in the classic Quadrupel style and adheres to the original 1946 recipe. The nitrogen version makes it more delicate, smooth, rich and creamy. *A perfect nitro pour takes a little time to settle, we appreciate your patience, as we serve it at its best.*

ACHOUFFE • N'Ice Chouffe
A spiced winter beer to enjoy from mid-October to mid-February. Smooth & strong, w/ spicy notes of thyme & curaçao, this dark beer warms hearts, making even the coldest winters joyful.

DE DOLLE • Dulle Teve
Brewed in the tradition of a Belgian Triple. It's high density stems from large amounts of pale malt increased with pale candi sugar in the brew kettle. Unfiltered and unpasteurized.

GOUDEN CAROLUS
Cuvée van de Keizer Imperial Dark 2023
Meaning "Grand Cru of the Emperor"; strong ale develops a refined complexity and intense aromas over the years. Smooth and fruity w/ a warming fullness. Complemented by notes of roasted malt, caramel, and plums.

DE GARRE by Van Steenberge
This gem of a Belgian Triple is the house beer for the famous pub of the same name, located down a long alley in Bruges.

A special malt blend gives this beer a complex character. Combining a delicate dryness with hints of coriander, dark fruits, anise and roasted chestnuts.

House Dark—Black Lager

Traditional Czech Dark Lager inspired by a Belgian from the 500-year-old U Fleků brewery in Prague. Rich & complex, black as coal; starts off like a Porter but finishes crisp, clean, & dry.

House Pale—Pale Ale

Belgian-inspired Pale Ale fermented w/ a yeast from a Belgian Trappist monastery. Brewed w/ trad European malts & Belgian candy sugar but hopped with modern American Simcoe & Sultana hops. Food-friendly everyday drinker.

SCRATCH • Beet Weiss

Berliner Weiss with a healthy dose of beets in the fermenter. The most purple beer they have ever made! Earthy with an aroma reminiscent of apples and pears, and light tartness on the finish. (Ava, IL)

CONISTON

Bluebird Bitter

Quite simply, a wonderful beer in the traditional English style. It has a nice orange aroma, balanced by biscuity malt. Tart and hoppy finish well-balanced by creamy malt. (Coniston, England)

ART HISTORY • Kräusen

A lager that is carbonated through the Kräusening process (adding a small amount of vigorously fermenting lager beer to a larger amount of lager beer that has just finished fermenting) Horizontally lagered. (Geneva, IL)

ART HISTORY • Fastenbier

A Franconian Dark Lenten Smoked Lager. Traditional smoked lager originally brewed in Germany by monks to drink while fasting for Lent. Slight sweetness, very low bitterness w/ flavors of toasted bread. (Geneva, IL)

DOVETAIL • Dunkel

Dark lager Inspired by a trip to a monastery brewery on the way to Bamberg; Chocolate, bread crust, and pretzel is lifted by spicy Hersbrucker and Saaz hops.

FRAUGRUBER • Pils

Pilsner produced by a German micro brewery. Regionality is a big issue for the brewery, having their own brewing barley of the Steffi and Marthe varieties; grown by 4 local farmers and then malted by a nearby malt house. (Bayern, Germany)

MOUNT SAINT BERNARD

Tynt Meadow Blond

Brewed using centuries-old Trappist traditions w/ a distinct English twist. Light & bittersweet in a classic English style, w/ nose of lemon zest & hints of orange, vanilla, & sherbet. (Leicestershire, England)

WARPIGS • Mussel Beach

A Hopleaf & WarPigs special collaboration, this witbeer was brewed for our World Famous Mussels & it happens to be a beer we all want to drink. Subtle vanilla & baking spice meet bright citrus from two varieties of orange peel. (Munster, IN)

ALLAGASH • White

IPA originally brewed under the name Daly Double. Flavors of nectarine/apricot, fleshy mango, with balanced bitterness.

Finnish style Sahti (type of Farmhouse ale) brewed w/ a combination of juniper berries, malted & unmalted rye, as well as peppery Belgian yeast. Boiled oak staves impart a tannic finish.

"East Coast" version of a West Coast-style IPA. Intense hop flavors and aromas of tropical & citrus fruits & pine dominate, w/ a subtle malt sweetness. (Freeport, ME)

Double hazy IPA w/ hand selected Nectar hops from MacHops in Motueka, New Zealand. Lots of peachy, pineapple-y goodness & a nice dankness. (Brooklyn, NY)

Russian Imperial Stout aged in Four Roses Bourbon barrels, then transferred to a whiskey barrel from Journeyman Distillery. This yielded only a few precious kegs. (Kalamazoo, MI)

Bourbon barrel aged imperial stout loaded with toasty marshmallow. (Milwaukee, WI)

Complex malt flavors are framed in oak w/ hints of dark chocolate, vanilla, tobacco, coconut and just a touch of dark cherry. (Paso Robles, CA)
