## TANDEM • Green Man

This semi-dry cider is created to pay homage to the Rhode Island Greening, a classic American apple. Made with Rhode Island Greening & McIntosh apples. (*Suttons Bay, MD*)

## HAYKIN

### Muscadet De Bernay 2023

This blend is dominated by Muscadet De Bernay, a cider apple found in the mid 1700's at a Benedictine Abbey in Bernay, France. It exudes the flavor of dark chocolate, blackberry, orange marmalade, & coffee. It is rich & complex. Muscadet De Bernay, blended with Dabinett and Zabergau Reinette apples from Idle Acres. (*Aurora, CO*)

### FARNUM HILL • Dooryard (Still)

Dry cider w/ aromas of honey, peach, and bittersweet apple. Taste of beeswax, lime, and citrus peels, w/ barely-perceptible sweetness. Bright acid, a full and moderately astringent mouthfeel. Little to no carbonation. (*Lebanon, NH*)

## VIRTUE • Jack Pine 2025

A blend of Dabinett, Northern Spy, Wine-sap, and Golden Russet from the 2023 and 2024 Harvest. A sharp and bright cider w/ a firm tannic finish. (*St. John's, MD*)

## DANSK MJØD • Odin's Skull

According to the legend Odin stole the first mead from the giants. A fresh, spicy mead with hops, tart apple juice and a hint of cinnamon. (*Billund, Denmark*)

The worlds oldest lambic brewery, Timmermans has brewed lambic in Itterbeek forover 300 years, since 1702. A few miles from the center of Brussels, it was previously known as "The Mole Brewery." Owned by Jan Vandermeulen, it was also a farm, an orchard, a café and a malt-house.

## Lambicus Blanc

A traditional lambic and, as with Belgian white beers, spiced with coriander. Refreshing, with flavors of wheat, citrus and spicy notes.

## Lambicus Faro

A historical Brussels beer. Candy sugar is delicately added to a traditional barrel-aged lambic, giving a sweeter note with apple aromas.

## DE LA SENNE • Witz

A light, 100% organic Brussels wheat beer that contains no spices, made with wheat & oats. The fact is that historically & contrary to popular belief, Belgian wheat beers didn't contain spices. Has a light refreshing acidity.

## DE LA SENNE • Stoutirik

Belgian Stout in the Irish style, light, dry, and freshly bitter with complex roasted notes. The scent is pleasantly fragranced by the presence of an English aromatic hop.

## PETRUS • Cranberry Rosé

A unique blend of Petrus Aged Pale Sour and De Brabandere's house Witbier, then blended with natural cranberry juice, for intense tart and fruity flavor.

## BAVIK • Super Pils Unfiltered

Pure pils. No adjustments. Never pasteurized. Unfiltered. Super tasty!

## DE RANKE • Hop Harvest

A Belgian Pale ale brewed annually w/ fresh, wet hops. Resulting in a fresh, floral, and pleasantly bitter taste.

## BOON • Geuze Sélection

To create their Geuze on draft, Boon had to create a new lambic blend by targeting specific foeders which were best suited to "keg conditioning." Tart and funky as a traditional lambic should be.

## BRASSERIE DUPONT

### Saison Dupont

Regarded as a classic Belgian seasonal ale, this beer was designed to quench the thirst of farm workers. Brewed in winter, it is left to ferment in wooden barrels before being served.

## DUVEL MOORTGAT • Duvel 6.66

A mild, full-bodied blonde ale. Just like the classic Duvel, it's based on the noble & exclusive hop varieties Sazaz and Styrian Golding. Mild, expressive & deliciously drinkable.

## WESTMALLE • Dubbel

For over 200 years, the monks of Westmalle have been choosing to live a life of prayer and work. There is a farm, a cheese dairy and a brewery inside the walls of the Trappist abbey. This beer is rich, complex, herby and fruity with a fresh-bitter finish.

## CHIMAY • Red Première

Brewed for the first time in 1862, it is the oldest of the Chimay Trappist beers. A balanced Dubbel w/ a blend of fruit and sweet biscuity malt flavors. Refreshing minerality & smooth bitterness.

## VAN STEENBERGE • Piraat 7

A strategically-hopped Belgian Tripel with soft floral and bright citrus hop flavors, it walks the line between Blonde ale, triple and a soft IPA. It is a true "living beer" with secondary fermentation.

## FANTÔME • Chocolat

A Belgian dark farmhouse ale made with cocoa and chili pepper. Earthy, tart, with a slightly spicy finish.

## MAREDSOUS • Brune

Abbey Brown brewed by Benedictine monks of the Abbey of Maredsous in the Belgian Ardennes. Originally only brewed for Christmas but has become a year round staple.

## KWAK by Bosteels

A traditional strong Belgian amber ale. Pauwel Kwak was a brewer and owner of the 'De Hoor' Inn in Dendermonde at the time of Napoleon. He commissioned a special Kwak glass to be blown, a glass that could be hung safely on a coach. Allowing any coachman who visited his inn to enjoy a beer on the road.

## TRIPEL KARMELIET by Bosteels

A classic golden Belgian Tripel. Brewed using a 3-grain recipe rediscovered from the 1679 Carmelite monastery; refined yet balanced, with soft fruity notes and a surprisingly delicate taste.

## BOERENERF • Gamay 2024

Made of Gamay grapes harvested at optimal ripeness in 2023, then carefully vinified & aged to preserve freshness & fruity brilliance. Blended w/ 2-year-old lambic at a ratio of about 40% wine to lambic. It was created in collaboration with Marc from Château de Durette (Beaujolais) & the grapes were grown in the Régnié terroir, one of the 10 crus of the AOC Beaujolais.

## ST. BERNARDUS • Abt 12 Nitro

Widely regarded as one of the best beers in the world. It is brewed in the classic Quadrupel style and adheres to the original 1946 recipe. The nitrogen version makes it more delicate, smooth, rich and creamy. \*A perfect nitro pour takes a little time to settle, we appreciate your patience, as we serve it at its best.\*

## ACHOUFFE • N'ice Chouffe

A spiced winter beer to enjoy from mid-October to mid-February. Smooth & strong, w/ spicy notes of thyme & curaçao, this dark beer warms hearts, making even the coldest winters joyful.

This gem of a Belgian Triple is the house beer for the famous pub of the same name, located down a long alley in Bruges.

### House Dark—Black Lager

Traditional Czech Dark Lager inspired by a classic from the 500-year-old U Fleků brewery in Prague. Rich & complex, black as coal; starts off like a Porter but finishes crisp, clean, & dry.

### House Pale—Pale Ale

Belgian-inspired Pale Ale fermented w/ a yeast from a Belgian Trappist monastery. Brewed w/trad European malts & Belgian candy sugar but hopped with modern American Simcoe & Sultana hops. Food-friendly everyday drinker.

## FOREST AND MAIN • Dark Mild

English Mild Ale w/ Maris Otter, British Crystal Malt, British Chocolate Malt, hopped w/ East Kent Goldings, and fermented w/ London ale yeast. Notes of gentle orange marmalade, whole wheat crackers, a fresh pot of English Breakfast Tea. (Amler, PA)

## SCRATCH • Beet Weiss

Berliner Weiss with a healthy dose of beets in the fermenter. The most purple beer they have ever made! Earthy with an aroma reminiscent of apples and pears, and light tartness on the finish. (Ava, IL)

## SURLY • Dry Irish Stout

Smooth, roasty & light-bodied w/ a dry chocolaty finish. (Minneapolis, MN)

## BRUTALIST • Industry Plant

A crisp clean American Lager brewed locally. Meant to quench your macro thirst with a artfully crafted lager.

## ART HISTORY • Fastenbier

A Franconian Dark Lenten Smoked Lager. Traditional smoked lager originally brewed in Germany by monks to drink while fasting for Lent. Slight sweetness, very low bitterness w/ flavors of toasted bread. (Geneva, IL)

## JEVER • Pilsener

Typifies the very dry style of pilsener from Friesland in the north-west corner of Germany. This remarkable beer is lagered for an impressive 90 days. (Jever, Germany)

## MOUNT SAINT BERNARD

### Tynt Meadow Blond

Brewed using centuries-old Trappist traditions w/ a distinct English twist. Light & bittersweet in a classic English style, w/ nose of lemon zest & hints of orange, vanilla, & sherbet. (Leicestershire, England)

## WARPIGS • Mussel Beach

A Hopleaf & WarPigs special collaboration, this witbier was brewed for our World Famous Mussels & it happens to be a beer we all want to drink. Subtle vanilla & baking spice meet bright citrus from two varieties of orange peel. (Munster, IN)

## ALLAGASH • White

Belgian-style wheat beer brewed w/ oats, malted wheat, & raw wheat. Spiced w/ their own special blend of coriander & Curaçao orange peel. Longtime Hopleaf mainstay! (Portland, ME)

## IS/WAS • Will Be

Saison brewed w/ spelt & triticale (wheat & rye hybrid grain.) Notes of mango, pineapple, white pepper, lemon zest, brioche, almond, & peach pits. Vibrant, zippy carbonation.

## FIRESTONE WALKER • Pivo Pils

Pivo is the beer that helped kick the doors down and liberated American pilsner from the clutches of industrial beer. Inspired by the dry-hopped Tipopils from Birrificio Italiano. Brewmaster Matt Brynildson drew upon multiple European influences to create this one-of-a-kind beer that sparked a legion of new craft pilsners across the U.S. (Paso Robles, CA) (Paso Robles, CA)

## DOVETAIL • Rauchbier

Traditional Bamberg recipe using beechwood smoked malt, with generous hopping to balance the smoked flavor.

## WEIHENSTEPHAN

**Kristallweissbier**  
A crystal clear wheat beer is a true jewel of the Bavarian State Brewery Weihenstephan. Fresh citrus aromas and fine banana notes are evident in the flavor, while the fine bubbles imparts a pleasant effervescence. (Freising, Germany)

## URBAN CHESTNUT

**Stammisch**  
Traditional German pilsner featuring a blend of Hallertau and Strisselspalt hops. Stammisch directly translating to 'table for regulars'. (St. Louis, MO)

A unique wheat beer, provides a body of light caramel and amber sweetness. Finished with fruity Rooibos tea to build a tower full of ripe stone fruit.

The first beer sold & brewed by Bell's in 1985 also the first Bell's beer the Hopleaf had on draft. Toasted & sweet caramel notes, balanced with herbal & citrus hop aromas. (Kalamazoo, MI)

**Close Encounter**  
Cascadian dark ale (Black IPA) w/ rich roasted malt character & an aggressive hop presence that will probe your taste buds like nothing you have experienced before.

This intensely hopped and gushing undead Pale Ale will be one's only respite after the zombie apocalypse. (Munster, IN)

Crisp IPA featuring New Zealand hops with aromas of sweet melon, berry and dried pine.

## OMMEGANG • Pale Sour

Gently tart, delicately sweet & refreshing, crafted exclusively by Liefmans, their sister blendery in Belgium. Begins w/ a mixed-culture fermentation in open copper vats, followed by months of aging. Master blenders regularly mix new batches w/ older ones to achieve the perfect balance of sweet & sour. (Cooperstown, NY)

## PRIMITIVE BEER

**Curating the Vibes**  
Multi-year sour blend aged on Rocky Mountain Cherries. A four-month maceration on whole fruit boasts a medley of complex cherry flavors that include baker's spice, almond, and burnt honey. (Longmont, CO)

## GOLDFINGER

**Ztotonator Doppelbock**  
The Munich monks invented the Doppelbock to sustain them during lengthy fasts. Rich malty sweetness, deep flavors of molasses, caramel, & dark fruit finish w/ an earthy mineral quality. Often referred to as "liquid bread." (Downers Grove, IL)

## MAPLEWOOD

**Zumo Beach**  
West Coast Double IPA made only w/ Zumo Hops. Lime zest & citrus, layered w/ notes of white grape, melon, & subtle tropical fruit. Crisp, bright & firmly bitter.

## ALLAGASH

**Foudre-Aged Belgian-Style Quad**  
A special version of their Belgian Quad Aged in an oak foudre for nine months w/ lactobacillus & pediococcus. Notes of red apple, strawberry, & stone fruit along w/ signature quad flavors of raisin & caramel, w/ a gently sour sweetness. (Portland, ME)
