

CIDER & MEAD DRAFTS

TANDEM • Smackintosh

McIntosh, Rhode Island Greening, and Northern Spy. Everything's better with a little Smack. This crowd pleaser is sweet and tart with full apple flavor. (*Suttons Bay, MI*)
4.5% **Goblet \$6.50**

ERIS • Punx

Semi-sweet cider blended with pineapple, cherry, and a hint of vanilla. Think of it as a Pineapple Upside Down cake with surprises.
6% **Goblet \$8**

VIRTUE • Estate Cider (2025)

A blend of Virtue estate grown apples, then hand-picked by their cidemakers from the orchard. Fermented and then aged in French oak & foeders. (*Fennville, MI*)

ST. AMBROSE CELLARS Star Thistle

Medium-sweet traditional mead made from the purple star thistle flower honey found in Michigan. (*Beulah, MI*)

VIRTUE • The Mitten Reserve 2021

Cider aged for a year in 2020 Bourbon County Brand Stout Birthday Barrels. The cidemakers work closely with partners to select the best barrels, taste and blend until the cider is perfect. Virtue's founder Gregory Hall is the mastermind behind Bourbon County Brand Stout and this is an homage to 10 years of making cider as well as the birth date of BCBS. Notes of brown sugar, toffee, stroopwafel and a strong bourbon finish. (*Fennville, MI*)

VINTAGE BELGIAN BOTTLES

*While law requires every beer to display an expiration date, we kindly ask you to regard it as you would a fine aged wine; a mere formality. Our cellared selections have not expired; they have simply had the good fortune of time.

RODENBACH • Caractère Rouge (2013)

Rare Flanders red ale blended from two-year oak-aged beer & young beer, it is macerated with fresh sour cherries, raspberries & cranberries for six months before bottle-conditioning. Tart, fruity w/ a vinous, Burgundy like finish. Some of the strong fruit flavors will be gone due to the age of the beer, but it is still drinking nicely.

RODENBACH • Vintage (2018)

A unique, unblended Flanders Red-Brown ale matured in oak casks for 2 years. Only the best casks are used, after which the beer is subjected to a strict sampling selection. It has a uniquely balanced acidic taste and a long, fresh and fruity aftertaste. Tasting beautifully for an 8 year old beer.

BOON • Framboise (2018)

Real raspberries are added to maturation process resulting in a complex fruit forward lambic. Strong notes of raspberry, cherry & a touch of vinegar. Balanced by soft acidity & fine carbonation.

DE LA SENNE • Nomi Hodaï (2022)

Collaboration w/ Oxbow brewing of Maine. Barley & rice malt pale ale, is still drinking great for 4 years old! Some of the herbal hop notes have faded but in their absence is a dry, light funk.
4.5% **11.2oz \$10**

BROUWERIJ VERHAEGHE • Echt Kriekenbier (2019)

A West-Flemish red-brown ale aged in oak wood & made w/ real cherries. The kriekenbier at its final composition is blended w/ 1 & 2-year old cherry beer.

ST-FEUILLEN • Quadrupel (2023)

Complex & finely caramelized aroma w/ shades of Madeira wine, candied fruit & an intense touch of fermentation esters. Bitterness is present but sweet & blends harmoniously w/ the malty structure.

CHIMAY • Première(RED) (2021)

The oldest of the Chimays. Its coppery color & sweet, fruity taste make it a particularly tasty dubbel ale.

VAL-DIEU • Blanche de Liège Rosée

A raspberry Witbier that is perfectly balanced. This fruity beer has delicious aromas of freshly picked raspberries balanced by the sparkling witbier.

FANTÔME • Hermine

A witbier w/ the spirit of a saison. Notes of coriander, bitter orange & a bold spice profile.
4.5% **25cl \$12**

DE KONINCK • Bolleke

This is the taste of Antwerp. Of rough docks and full terraces. Of cargo bikes and summer evenings near the river bank. Slightly malty, slightly hoppy with a hint of caramel.

LIEFMANS • Kriek-Brut

A blend of Oud Bruin & Goudenband from different vintages, w/ black cherries. It matures over a year & a half, allowing the flavors of wood & almond to become more intense & complex.

BOON • Geuze Sélection

To create their Geuze on draft, Boon had to create a new lambic blend by targeting specific foeders which were best suited to "keg conditioning." Tart and funky as a traditional lambic should be.

BRASSERIE DUPONT

Saison Dupont

Regarded as a classic Belgian seasonal ale, this beer was designed to quench the thirst of farm workers. Brewed in winter, it is left to ferment in wooden barrels before being served.

DUVEL MOORTGAT • Duvel 6.66

A mild, full-bodied blonde ale. Just like the classic Duvel, it's based on the noble & exclusive hop varieties Saaz & Styrian Golding. Mild, expressive & deliciously drinkable.

WESTMALLE • Dubbel

For over 200 years, the monks of Westmalle have been choosing to live a life of prayer and work. There is a farm, a cheese dairy and a brewery inside the walls of the Trappist abbey. This beer is rich, complex, herby and fruity with a fresh-bitter finish.
7% **33cl \$14**

WESTMALLE • Duo

A golden blonde is a blend of 60% Tripel & 40% Extra. It has the freshness of Extra w/ the fruity body of Tripel. Resulting in a refined balance of hop & fruit aromas.

LEROUY • Poperings Hommelbier

Hoppy Golden strong ale w/ orange, grapefruit notes from the hops. A sweet hoppy honeyed finish w/ a hint of cumin spice.

MAREDSOUS • Brune

Abbey Brown brewed by Benedictine monks of the Abbey of Maredsous in the Belgian Ardennes. Originally only brewed for Christmas but has become a year round staple.

ST. BERNARDUS • Prior 8

A traditional abbey beer, brewed in the classic dubbel style. The original recipe dates back to 1946. Named "World's Best Dark Belgian Style Dubbel" at the World Beer Awards, in other words, the best Dubbel beer in the world.

TRIPLE KARMELIET by Bosteels

A classic golden Belgian Tripel. Brewed using a 3-grain recipe rediscovered from the 1679 Carmelite monastery; refined yet balanced, with soft fruity notes and a surprisingly delicate taste.

KWAK by Bosteels

A traditional strong Belgian amber ale. Pauwel Kwak was a brewer and owner of the 'De Hoorn' Inn in Dendermonde at the time of Napoleon. He commissioned a special Kwak glass to be blown, a glass that could be hung safely on a coach. Allowing any coachman who visited his inn to enjoy a beer on the road.

CHIMAY

Blue (Grande Réserve)

First brewed as a Christmas beer by the monks of Scourmont Abbey in 1956. It begins with a light sweet note before the creamy caramel transitions to a soft Mocha combined with an intense spicy taste, culminating in a delicious candied fruit finish.

ACHOUFFE • Chouffe IPA

Belgian IPA w/ pronounced bitterness yet balanced by a fruit undertone. Formerly known as Houblon Chouffe.

DE GARRE by Van Steenberge

This gem of a Belgian Triple is the house beer for the famous pub of the same name, located down a long alley in Bruges.

HUYGHE

Mongozo Coconut

A witbier made w/ buckwheat & blended with fresh coconut. Tropical.
3.6% **25cl \$12**

Floris Cactus

Traditional Belgian Wheat beer made with cactus. Delicate and a lightly sweet, soft notes of green apple.

Delirium Red

Cherry ale that is sweet and fruity, with a nice balance between sweet and sour. Hints of almond and mildly sour cherries.

RODENBACH • Grand Cru

A unique, unblended Flanders Red-Brown ale matured in oak casks for 2 years. Only the best casks are used, after which the beer is subjected to a strict sampling selection. It has a uniquely balanced acidic taste and a long, fresh and fruity aftertaste. Age only adds to the complexity.

GOUDEN CAROLUS Tripel (2023)

Originally brewed for the Knights of the Golden Fleece in 1491. Brewed w/ the best Belgian ripe barley & hops.

House Dark—Black Lager

Traditional Czech Dark Lager inspired by a classic from the 500-year-old U Fleků brewery in Prague. Rich & complex, black as coal; starts off like a Porter but finishes crisp, clean, & dry.

4.8% Pint \$7.50

House Pale—Pale Ale

Belgian-inspired Pale Ale fermented w/ a yeast from a Belgian Trappist monastery. Brewed w/ trad European malts & Belgian candy sugar but hopped with modern American Simcoe & Sultana hops. Food-friendly everyday drinker.

HALF ACRE • Little Horse

IPA w/ a soft malt base, flavors of citrus, guava & dank resin.

3.5% Pint \$6.50

GOLDFINGER**Summer Beer**

An all German malt, single decocted, Leichtbier (light lager) hopped with Spalter Select and Saphir hops. Infinitely refreshing.

(Downers Grove, IL) 4% Pint \$8

OFF COLOR**Blueberry Yuzu Fierce**

Berliner Weiss brewed with blueberry and yuzu. Complex citrus profile with enough clean lactic acidity and juicy fruit ester to create sweet tart backbone.

4.2% Teku Glass \$7

ART HISTORY • Kräusen

A lager that is carbonated through the Kräusen process (adding a small amount of vigorously fermenting lager beer to a larger amount of lager beer that has just finished fermenting) Horizontally lagered.

(Geneva, IL) 4.6% Pint \$6

WALDHAUS • Hell

Light lager from the Black Forest made w/ local water, Tettnang, Spalt & Hallertau hops. Crisp w/ malty freshness.

(Weilheim, Germany) 4.6% Teku Glass \$12

SCRATCH • Estate Saison

Classic farmhouse ale brewed w/ grain from Sugar Creek Malt, their own estate-grown Cascade and Chinook hops, and fermented with their house yeast culture. Dry-hopped in the fermenter for a touch of added tropical aroma.

(Ava, IL) 4.8% Goblet \$11

JEVER • Pilsener

Typifies the very dry style of pilsener from Friesland in the north-west corner of Germany. This remarkable beer is lagered for an impressive 90 days.

(Jever, Germany) 4.9% .4L \$9

SIERRA NEVADA • Otra Vez

Tart gose made w/ lime and blue agave nectar. Bright lime flavor & a mild sweetness from the agave are finished with a touch of salt.

(Chico, CA) 4.9% Teku Glass \$7

SAMUEL SMITH**Nut Brown Ale**

Brewed w/ well water (the original well at the Old Brewery, sunk in 1758, is still in use, w/ the hard well water being drawn from 85 feet underground.) Fermented in 'stone Yorkshire squares' to create a dry ale w/ rich nutty flavors of beech nuts, almonds & walnuts.

(Tadcaster, England) 5% Pint \$11

WARPIGS • Mussel Beach

A Hopleaf & WarPigs special collaboration, this witbier was brewed for our World Famous Mussels & it happens to be a beer we all want to drink. Subtle vanilla & baking spice meet bright citrus from two varieties of orange peel.

(Munster, IN) 5.1% Pint \$7

URBAN CHESTNUT • Zwickel

Classically crafted, timeless, European-style lager is an unfiltered, unpasteurized, German classic that finishes as a smooth-drinking, naturally cloudy bier.

(St. Louis, MO) 5.1% Pint \$7.50

AYINGER • Bräuweisse

Full-bodied Hefeweizen, with a champagne-like sparkle. A light, typical wheat beer taste is expressed, the bitter tone of which can scarcely be detected.

(Germany) 5.1% .5L \$11

HOPEWELL • Kristalweizen

Crystal-clear, filtered version of their classic style Hefeweizen. Refreshing banana & clove notes w/ a crisp finish.

5.2% Teku Glass \$9

ALLAGASH • White

Belgian-style wheat beer brewed w/ oats, malted wheat, & raw wheat. Spiced w/ their own special blend of coriander & Curaçao orange peel. Longtime Hopleaf mainstay!

(Portland, ME) 5.2% Pint \$8.50

IS/WAS • Mooncusser

Spelt Saison made w/ oyster shells & sea salt. Notes of sea air, cucumber, lemon zest, hay, wet stones, honeydew, black pepper & a soft mouthfeel.

5.4% Goblet \$7

SUPERMOON • Commonbier

California common or "Steam" beer, brewed with lager yeast, which creates a clean refreshing balance for an amber.

(Milwaukee, WI) 5.6% Pint \$9

'T IJ • Blondie

Belgian style Blond ale is crisp w/ slight malt aromas. Brewed w/ their own IJ yeast.

(Amsterdam, Netherlands) 5.8% 25cL \$11

PERENNIAL**Giant Steps Blend 6**

Belgian style ale aged in French oak barrels with cucumber, juniper, grapefruit, and lime.

(St. Louis, MO) 6% 25cL \$12

GREEN MAN • Porter

Made of a rich flavorful blend of English Crystal & roast malts hung on a backbone of Simpsons Golden Promise. Hops stay out of the way allowing the malt complexity to shine.

(Asheville, NC) 6% Pint \$8

CROOKED STAVE**New Zealand Pilsner**

A twist on a classic German-style, this Pilsner is brewed and lightly dry-hopped with the citrusy/tropical hops from New Zealand. Hand-selected by the brew team each year. Clean and crisp, yet expressive and unique.

(Denver, CO) 6.2% Pint \$7

3 FLOYDS • Zombie Dust

This intensely hopped and gushing undead Pale Ale will be one's only respite after the zombie apocalypse.

(Munster, IN) 6.5% Pint \$8

FAT ORANGE CAT**Baby Kittens**

A lovely hazy IPA. Medley of fresh citrus, mangos, and pineapple. It finishes with a hint of pine and invigorating grapefruit.

(East Hampton, CT) 6.5% Pint \$7

SAINT ERRANT**Temperance Gatecrasher**

Back again & being brewed Saint Errant. This English style IPA stands apart from ultra bitter IPA's. Balanced w/ bountiful aromatic hops & a touch of malt sweetness.

(Evanston, IL) 6.6% Pint \$8

BLIND CORNER**Cinematic Slumber**

Hazy IPA w/ notes of candied orange peel, ripe berry pulp & a faint floral creaminess.

(Naperville, IL) 6.6% Pint \$9

WELDWERKS • Juicy Bits

Hazy IPA with citrus and tropical fruit hop character from the Mosaic, Citra & El Dorado hops.

(Greeley, CO) 6.7% Pint \$10

CEREBRAL • Conduit Lab

American IPA made with Mosaic, Simcoe & Columbus Cryo hops. Notes of dank blueberry, fruit stripe gum & blue raspberry.

(Denver, CO) 7% Teku Glass \$12

DOVETAIL**Vignette: Pinot Noir (2022)**

Made in the Senne Valley tradition. Spontaneously fermented & aged in oak for at least two years, once barrels are selected it is blended to mature another few months on pinot noir grapes.

SIDE PROJECT**Cassis du Fermier #4 (2025)**

A blend of 75% appalachian spontaneous Saison aged w/ black currants in French Oak wine barrels. The brightness, depth & rustic character are created by the wild yeast native to their family's Missouri farm. Fermented & aged in wine barrels for several months.

(Maplewood, MO) 8% 25cL \$12

THE VEIL • whiteferrari

Soft double IPA hopped intensely w/ 50/50 Citra & Galaxy (& a ton of it!). They used the freshest hop crop available for an insanely expressive hop character.

(Richmond, VA) 8% Teku Glass \$12

UNIBROUE**La Fin du Monde**

A Belgian triple style that is a tribute to Quebec, the land encountered by 16th-century French explorers who thought they'd reached the end of the world.

(Chambly, QC, Canada) 9% 25cL \$7

3 FLOYDS**ChemTrailMix (2021)**

Dark Lord imperial stout aged in bourbon barrels with Mekong cinnamon and pink peppercorns.

(Munster, IN) 15% 5oz Snifter \$12

DEEP WOOD SERIES**REVOLUTION****Peach Brandy Barrel D.B.V.S.O.J.**

This three-year-spanning cuvee of Straight Jacket Barleywine hailed from a mix of American & French oak bourbon & rum barrels before its terminal six-month repose in Peach Brandy casks. A marriage of young & old components provides a harmonious balance of breadly, fruity malt expressions.

HALF ACRE**Triple Barrel Catch Hell (2026)**

Imperial stout aged in a dizzying array of wood. Willett, Eagle Rare, Russel's Reserve, Buffalo Trace & Weller at different ages combine across each round of barreling. Total barrel time of 33 months. Finer points of snappy Saigon cinnamon and sleepy vanilla.
